USBC #04966 Certified Tournament - Official Entry Form – Tournament Rules

1. Tournament will consist of two squads, **9:30 AM & 1:00 PM**; available lanes may restrict squad size.
2. Teams shall consist of four (4) members in good standing of a Michigan 700 Bowling Club of America. All bowlers must be USBC sanctioned. Unsanctioned participants may buy an associate USBC membership card (\$18) or pay a participation fee (\$5).
3. Entrants can compete **TWICE, BUT YOU MUST CHANGE TWO (2) TEAMMATES.** No more than two professional bowlers per team.
4. This is a handicap tournament. Each team will bowl three games, and receive handicap of **90%** of their combined entering averages less than **920** pins. Teams may go over the **920** pins in team average, but will receive **NO** Handicap.
5. Entering average:
 - A. Your 2010-2011 highest USBC yearbook (winter) average of 21 or more games.
 - B. Your 2009-2010 highest USBC yearbook (winter) average of 21 or more games.
 - C. If no prior yearbook averages are available then the highest current season USBC certified league average as of 10/10/10 for 21 or more games.
 - D. Bowlers with none of the above averages will be valued with a 230 average.
6. Closing times for available entries will be 30 minutes before scheduled start of squad (unless the squad is full).
7. All prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least one prize for every 8 entries. If 80 teams compete at least 10 teams will cash.
8. Each bowler must have bowled a certified 700 series and are members in good standing of a State of Michigan 700 Club.
9. Non members can become members by paying membership fees the day of tournament.
10. Any bowler falsifying average will be disqualified in accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3 which states in part: Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series.
11. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
12. Prize checks and tournament results will be mailed to club Pin Buoys within 30 days after the tournament ends.
13. USBC Rule 319a-2 (10 pin average rule), Rule 319e-2 (15 pin average rule) and 319d (prize winnings) are waived for all participants in this tournament.
14. No prize money will be paid out the day of the tournament; all prize money will be mailed, or distributed to the captains of the winning teams.
15. **Please observe our Dress Code - Slacks, Skirts, Skorts, or Pants (Red, Black, White, or Blue) are standard for all 700 Club Tournaments. Dress Codes are diligently enforced for Flint 700 Club Bowlers. Those (Flint Chapter 28 Bowlers) in violation will be assessed a fine of \$5.00 (multiple offences could result in bowler being dismissed from competition). NO SHORTS.**
16. \$1.00 will be donated to the prize fund by each 700 CLUB for each of their members entered in this tournament. This will be added to the prize fund.
