## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only USBC certified bowlers are eligible to bowl.
2. Tournament will consist of two squads, 10:00 AM & 1:30 PM; available lanes may restrict squad size.
3. Entrants can compete **TWICE, BUT YOU MUST CHANGE YOUR PARTNER.**
4. This is a handicap tournament. Each team will receive handicap of 100% of their combined 2006-2007 yearbook averages less than 425 pins.
5. Doubles teams combined 2006-2007 year book averages can not exceed 425 pins.
6. Entering average:
  - A. Last season 2006-2007 highest USBC yearbook average of 21 or more games.
  - B. Rule 319e-2 (15 pins over average) is in effect. If you have a current league average of at least 21 games as of 11/25/07 that is 15 pins over your highest yearbook average for 2006-2007 season then you must adjust your roster/average for tournament play.
  - C. If no average last season, highest current season USBC certified league average as of 11/25/07 for 21 or more games.
  - D. Bowlers with neither of the above averages will be valued with a 225 average.
7. Closing times for entries will be 15 minutes before scheduled time to bowl; closing time is 10:15 AM for Squad A, closing time is 1:15 PM for Squad B; available lanes may restrict squad size.
8. All prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least 1 prize for every 8 entries.
9. Each bowler must have bowled a certified 700 series and be a member in good standing of the Flint 700 Club Chapter 28. .
10. Non members of the Flint 700 Club can become members by paying (a one time fee of) \$50.00 membership fees the day of tournament. Each new member will receive their own club bowling shirt.
11. Any bowler falsifying average will be disqualified in accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3 which states in part: Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series.
12. All decisions of the tournament management (Robert Tubbs, Tournament Manager) are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
13. Prize checks and tournament results will be mailed to bowlers within 30 days after the tournament ends.
14. USBC Rule 319a-2 (10 pin average rule) and 319d (prize winnings) are waived for all participants in this tournament.
15. No prize money will be paid out the day of the tournament; all prize money will be mailed / distributed to the winning individuals within 30 days.
16. 700 club shirts may be worn with pride in tournaments and leagues. **Slacks, skorts, skirts, or pants (Dark Blue, Black, or Red) are standard for all 700 Club tournaments. Dress Codes are diligently enforced. Those in violation will be assessed a fine of \$5.00.**
