- 1. Only USBC Certified bowlers are eligible to bowl. Bowlers must have valid 2010-2011 USBC certification card at time of tournament check in. Certified bowlers without cards on the tournament site will have prize monies withheld until we can verify membership.
2. Tournament will consist of two team squads 9:00AM & 1:00PM Saturdays (Galaxy Bowling Center), and two doubles & singles squads 9:00AM & 2:00PM Sundays (Galaxy Bowling Center). Available lanes may restrict squad size. Check in is one hour prior to squad time.
3. Entrants can compete only once in the Doubles & Singles events, but may compete TWICE IN THE TEAM EVENT, BUT MUST CHANGE 2 PARTNERS. Bowlers first team event will count toward bowlers All-Events Score (Team, Doubles, and Singles Handicap Scores combined).
4. This is a handicap tournament. Each Bowler/Team will receive handicap of 80% of the difference of their tournament average and 220 pins per game. Doubles team members averages will be combined and receive handicap of 80% of the difference of their combined tournament averages and 440 pins per game. Team event members averages will be combined and receive handicap of 80% of the difference of their tournament averages and 880 pins per game. Teams over 880 pins, and doubles teams over 440 pins in average will bowl scratch (no handicap).
5. Averages: Bowlers shall use their highest 2009-2010 USBC Yearbook Average. Bowlers without a 2009-2010 USBC Yearbook Average may use their highest current average (21 games or more) for 2009-2010 as of 04/30/11. If the average being used is from a SPORTS LEAGUE, it MUST be clearly identifiable on the application. All bowlers without proof of average will purchase a certification card, and bowl scratch (220 average, no handicap, no exceptions). Averages are subject to verification and any bowler found to have a higher average than the submitted or a non-disclosed SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGE may be cause for forfeiture of all prize money and awards.
6. Professional Bowlers: Not more than two professionals on a 4-bowler team and only one on a two bowler doubles team.
7. Entries must be post-marked by May 31, 2011. Squads are assigned on a first come/first serve basis. If the squad is full we will do our best to assign you to a squad that same day/weekend.
8. All prize money will be returned 100% at a MINIMUM ratio of at least one prize for every 7 entries. Tournament Champions will receive awards.
9. This tournament is open to ALL members of the National 700 Clubs of America whose chapter's dues are current. Chapter Pin Buoys must verify that the bowler's dues are current. If you are not part of a Local 700 Club an unattached 700 Club National membership could be purchased for \$10.
10. Any bowler falsifying average will be disqualified in accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3 which states in part: Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series.
11. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
12. Prize checks and tournament results will be mailed to designated captains within 30 days after the tournament ends.
13. USBC Rule 319a-2 (10 pin average rule), 319 (D) (prize winnings), and 319 (E) (15 pin average rule) are waived for all participants in this tournament.
14. Please no shorts, no hats, and no tank tops t-shirts (sleeveless). 700 club shirts should be worn with pride in tournaments.
15. Fees are \$25 per bowler, per event; with an optional \$5 all events (combined handicap score from Team, Doubles, and Singles). Total fees for full participation are \$80 per bowler.
16. A late bowler or team will be allowed to bowl. But, the score will start in the frame is which bowlers on that pair are in. If two lanes of bowlers are late, their score will begin in the frame of the teams on the adjoining pairs. The bowler will receive zero (0) for all missed frames.
17. Substitutions are subject to verification of average, and current 700 Club Membership (Dues paid to date).
18. Line Up, Squad, and Time Selections (Enter Full Names) *THIS WILL BE THE ORDER THAT YOU WILL BOWL* New this year bowlers 55 and over may select SENIOR ALL EVENTS, AND SENIOR SINGLES.
