TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only USBC Certified bowlers are eligible to bowl.
2. Tournament will consist of one squad @ 10:00 AM – **The Tournament Field is Limited to the first 56 Teams!**
3. Entrants can compete only once. Each team is 4 members. Each bowler completes three games.
4. This is a handicap tournament. Each team will receive handicap of 100% of their combined 2010-2011 highest yearbook averages less than 860 pins. **Teams over the 860 pin combined team average will not be accepted.**
5. Entering average:
 - A. Your 2010-2011 highest USBC yearbook average of 21 or more games.
 - B. If no 2010-2011 yearbook average is available then the highest current season USBC certified league average as of 09/19/2011 for 21 or more games.
 - C. Bowlers with neither of the above averages will be valued with a 220 average.
6. Closing times for available entries will be 30 minutes before scheduled start of squad (unless the squad is full).
7. All prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of at least one prize for every 8 entries. Prize money will be determined by where a team finishes prior to the BAKER ELIMINATION ROUND.
8. Each bowler must have bowled a certified 700 series and be a member in good standing of the Flint 700 Club.
9. Non members of the Flint 700 Club can become members by paying \$60.00 membership fees the day of tournament.
10. Any bowler falsifying average will be disqualified in accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3 which states in part: Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series.
11. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
12. Prize checks and tournament results will be mailed to bowlers within 30 days after the tournament ends.
13. USBC Rule 319a-2 (10 pin average rule), Rule 319e-2 (15 pin average rule) and 319d (prize winnings) are waived for all participants in this tournament.
14. No prize money will be paid out the day of the tournament; all prize money will be mailed, or distributed to the captains of the winning teams.
15. **Please observe our Dress Code – 700 Club Shirts and Slacks, Skorts, or Pants (Red, Black, White, or Blue) are standard for all 700 Club Tournaments. Dress Codes are diligently enforced for Flint 700 Club Bowlers. Those (Flint Chapter 28 Bowlers) in violation will be assessed a fine of \$5.00 (multiple offences could result in bowler being dismissed from competition). NO SHORTS. New Members need to wear a collared shirt and the appropriate slacks, skorts, or pants.**
16. The top 4, 6, 8, 12, or 16 teams (based on number of total entries) after 3 complete games will advance to the BAKER ELIMINATION ROUND. In the BAKER ELIMINATION ROUND teams will be seeded into a bracket for head-to-head elimination matches. These matches will be 20 frames (2 games) by each team total pins to decide winner. Each member of the four man team will bowl a frame taking turns in order. The winning team will receive additional prize money provided by the Flint 700 Club. There is NO handicap in the BAKER ELIMINATION ROUND. Ties will be broken with a 4 frame roll off (frames 7 through 10). Higher seeds start on the left lane.
